Ready for Some Summer Fun?

LEGO LOVERS (Grades K-3)

Are you a Lego fan? Do you build, take apart, and build again? We'll play with Legos and inspire the future scientists and mathematicians inside ourselves.

(Grades 4-8 - Beginning) Do you want to learn how to design a basic robot that you have programmed to perform a task? Students will design a robot; learn team building skills; problem solve and download a program on the robot. This curriculum is designed to help students prepare for a First Lego League team. Students MUST be mature enough to sit at a computer for instruction plus learn to work and share as a team.

(Grades 5-8 - Advanced) This session is for students that have PRIOR experience programming and building with Lego Robotics. By the end of this camp, students will have completed a secret mission using a robot they have engineered.

"BECOME A SCIENCE GOO-RU" (Grades K-8)

Join us for ooey gooey science experiments. Get your hands dirty while learning about fun science facts. You will bring home project samples like play dough, gack, flubber, and other fun creations.

"SMOOTHIES AND SNACKS" (Grades K-8)

Get your creative juices flowing, literally! Find out some great ways to get your fruits and veggies this summer, while the produce is ripe and ready. We'll also find some ways to preserve the produce to use when the growing season is over.

SPORTS 101 – LET'S MOVE! (Grades K-8)

Sports 101 – Soccer/Volleyball/Basketball/Outdoor recreation/Dance/Karate (Kub, Boce ball, Frisbee golf, Cowboy golf)

"AMERICAN GIRLS" (Grades K-8)

Travel through history with the American Girls. Cook food, make crafts and recreate lifestyles from cultures from different time periods in America's history. You will also learn how fun teamwork can be by working on projects with your new friends.

"BABYSITTERS BOOT CAMP" (Grades 5-8)

Hey future babysitters! This is the session for you to get your babysitting business on its way! Come learn childcare basics and quick activities to get you started. You will also make a babysitting kit equipped with the essentials for every babysitter. Campers will earn Basic First Aid & CPR, finish the week with their American Red Cross Babysitting Certification and First Aid/CPR Certification.

"ART INSPIRED BY LIFE" (Grades K-8)

This camp is a hands-on exploration of visual arts. Get inspired to express yourself! We will use nature and literature to inspire us. We will study nature to draw, paint, and use it to make small sculptural creations.

"MAKE THE CUT!" (DRAMA) (Grades K-8)

The instructor will lead campers through the key elements of drama such as pantomime, script reading, ensemble building and the process and parts of theatre production. Whether you are a natural 'ham' or just want to come out of your shell a bit, participate in some great activities to inspire your inner actor.

"RHYTHM TO ROOTS" (Grades K-8)

Learning Gardens inspire a sense of environmental stewardship and strength in self and others. We will work as a team to grow fresh fruits and vegetables to learn farming and culinary skills, experience nature and explore community issues of health and wellness. At Parrish Middle School's aquaponic garden.

"KIDS INVENT" (Grades K-8)

Join us as we build things and blow things up...all in the name of science and invention! You will use creative problem solving a critical thinking to design, build and test models that float, fly and roll. We'll solve everyday technology based problems as a group or individual.

"OUT OF THIS UNIVERSE" (Grades K-8)

Let's get out of this world! When the days are longer and the skies are clearer, we have more time to explore outer space. You will study the stars and chart your course for the future. We will also do a little dabbling in some Science Fiction as well!

"GEO-CACHE SALEM RACE": (Grades 6 & Up)

Geo-cache by foot in Salem. You will work in teams to locate various hidden treasures. Explore Salem in a whole new way. We will travel by foot, so no need to bring your own equipment.

"KONNICHIWA!" (Japanese) (Grades 4-8)

This camp will give you a glimpse into Japanese culture as well as a sampling of language and writing! We will explore Japanese holidays/celebrations, schools, games, foods, and many other cultural aspects. Hands on, enrichment activities include: chopsticks 101, writing kanji characters, origami, traditional toys, Japanese snacks, and much more!

"WRITE ON!" (Grades 4-8)

Explore the beauty of your words! You will write poetry, songs, comics and short stories, using various creative writing processes. You will discover ways to present your words such as with calligraphy and using illustrations.

"MULTICULTURAL ART/CRAFTS" (Grades K-8)

Explore the other side of the world! Without ever leaving Salem, you can learn about other cultures. You will learn sights, sounds, artistic contributions, and customs of other countries. We will share short stories and complete art projects inspired by those cultures.

"BRICKS AND MORTAR ALL DAY" (Grades K-8)

Learn to build masterpiece architecture using the lego bricks. We will look at famous landmarks, cover some of the terms of the trade, and actually construct our own cities!

"CREEPY CRAWLY CRITTERS" (Grades K-8)

Do you love the grossness of the creepy crawly critters? This camp is all about the purpose and processes involved in the lives of these underappreciated bugs and slugs. Anything from life cycles, trying their diets, and dissecting to see what they are really made of!

"MAKE A CLAY MOVIE" (Grades 4-8)

Do you have ambitions to work for Disney or Pixar? To make your dreams come true, come build your own characters and make a short film in this exciting camp!

"CALL TO THE COLLEGE BOUND!" (Writer's Workshop) (Grades 6 & Up)

This writer's workshop is the best thing you can do to get prepared for college! Have fun with the intent of completing the steps to becoming a college student. Learn some tricks of the trade you won't find in your High School English Class! Get familiar with the types of essay questions on college scholarship applications and also explore different writing styles and models for college classes.

"SALEM FENCING ACADEMY" (Grades 6 & Up)

Learn how to move like Zoro! Just imagine the sword fights on pirate ships you could do after a week here!
